Special Condition 8 requires that by March 1st of each year, the permittee shall submit a summary report describing any leaks that occurred in the previous year, corrections that were made, and a summary of any other maintenance performed on the pipe. This report satisfies this requirement for the January 1 to December 31, 2008 reporting period.

Effluent Pipe Leaks (1/1/2008 – 12/31/2008) – No effluent pipe leaks occurred in 2008.

Maintenance Performed (1/1/2008 – 12/31/2008) – Phase 3 of the Ocean Effluent Pipeline Replacement Project was initiated in June and completed in August of 2008. The 18-inch pipeline was replaced with 24-inch concrete cylinder pipe from the Fruitvale Valve Station (just east of the Booster Pump Station) to the Harney Street Valve Station in Newport (13,650 lineal feet). One 3000-foot section left over from the Phase 2 project in 2007 is planned for replacement in 2009: Tax Lot 700 in Toledo including Dahl Hill.


Pressure/Vacuum Valve Maintenance (1/1/2008 – 12/31/2008):

- In addition to installing all the new valves on the new section of pipe, one other valve was replaced in 2008 (21-06). This valve is located on the older 21-inch line in Toledo.
